

SUMMER SCHOOL UDG"THE HISTORY OF THE FUTURE"

Theme for 2025: Culture and Innovation



General aims of the summer school:

- The paradigm of the relationship between culture and innovation
- · Networking the students from different parts of the world
- Preparation for working in conditions of uncertainty
- · Understanding cultures and working with different cultures
- Understanding and training for work in unfamiliar and constantly changing circumstances
- The summer school will carry **3 ECTS** credits and will be recognized by partner universities

Prerequisites:

- Students of all study years from partner universities
- · Willingness to work in a team
- · Openness to other cultures
- English language proficiency (minimum **B2 level** according to ECEFR)



Additional prerequisites:

- Participants must disclose any allergies and/or acute illnesses that could affect their participation in school activities during the application process.
- Participants agree to share accommodation with other school participants.
- Participants must obtain travel insurance for the entire duration of the program.

Learning outcomes:

- Enhancing critical thinking skills and abilities
- Understanding the relationship between culture and innovation
- Understanding the impact of nation's culture influence to innovations within the society
- Understanding how investment in innovation can foster an entrepreneurial culture among young people
- · Ability to analyze examples of innovation in different cultural contexts
- Ability of recognizing that culture is a fundamental productive force in society
- Demonstrating initiative and an entrepreneurial spirit in connecting cultural resources with innovative practices

Application:

• Essay on the topic **How do you understand connection between** culture and innovation?

An essay should be written from the perspective of the participant's country of origin

An essay should be written with 6500 characters minimum.
